Created in 2008, the Federal Institute of Education, Science and Technology of Rio de Janeiro (IFRJ in Portuguese acronym) is an institution of the Federal Network of Professional, Scientific and Technological Education, linked to the Education Ministry.

IFRJ acts in different levels and modalities of teaching, being organized in a multi-campus and multidisciplinary structure, in which teaching, research and extension activities are developed.

The Institute's History is consolidated by the articulation of the former Chemistry Federal Technical School and the Nilo Peçanha Agricultural School, uniting more than 110 years of tradition.
